3. All exhibits must be properly tagged, giving name, address and age. **PLEASE COVER NAME FOR JUDGING.** Judging will be Thursday.
4. Exhibitors must provide their own tools, and all other things needed for arranging, holding and displaying exhibits.
5. **All exhibits must be brought in Wednesday between 12:00 noon and 7:30 PM. Exhibits may only be picked up Sunday after 7:15 PM or Monday between 3:00 PM and 7:00 PM.**
6. Exhibitors ticket for Boys & Girls 13 thru 15 may be purchased from the Secretary at the time of entry and entitles holder to exhibit in any or all departments and admission to the Fair for four days. Children 12 years and under FREE.
7. Boys and Girls may enter Adult classes but will be subject to Adult rules.
8. Exhibitors must forward a list of their exhibits to be received by the Fair Secretary **ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1ST.** Send to P.O. Box 24, Somers, CT 06071.
9. Use one (1) Entry Form per exhibitor. Entry Forms are in the "Entry Forms" section of this book.
10. An item can NOT be entered in two lots.

2. **WATER** in the bottom of it so he can keep wet.
3. **FOOD**, such as live insects to eat.
4. **SHADE** to keep him out of the heat of the sun.
