

CATTLE – CLASSES 36 THRU 42

RULES

1. **Connecticut Fairs Livestock and Show Regulations - 2011 are on pages 9-13 of this premium book.** Four Town Fair Cattle Committee will be collecting and/or checking all health certificates of each animal entered. All Connecticut Fair Livestock and Show Regulations will be enforced with no exceptions.
2. No cattle dealer may compete.
3. Where there is no competition the judge reserves the right to award the premium according to the merit of the animal.
4. Owners and/or exhibitors are responsible for any and all damages to persons or any property their animals or themselves may inflict. Owners and/or exhibitors will be solely responsible for the behavior of their animals on all Four Town Fair property.
5. No bulls over the age of 4 months may be shown (age as of September 1)
6. Cattle to be shown Friday will be allowed in the barn THURSDAY after 2 p.m. Cattle to be shown Saturday will be allowed in the barn THURSDAY AFTER-NOON and FRIDAY after 10 a.m. (cows in milk to be in SATURDAY by 9 a.m. and MUST BE OKAYED BY A SUPERINTENDENT) Beef to be shown Friday should be brought on THURSDAY after 2 p.m. Beef to be shown Sunday should be in THURSDAY after 2 p.m. or FRIDAY after 10 a.m. Any questions regarding arrivals should be brought to the attention of the superintendents.
7. ALL ANIMALS ARE CONSIDERED ON EXHIBIT UPON ARRIVAL AT THE FAIR GROUNDS AND SHOULD BE IN FITTED SHOW CONDITION UPON ENTERING THE GROUNDS.
8. Exhibitors must forward a list of their entries to the Fair Secretary no later than 10 days before the fair. Barn space is limited so entries will be on a first come, first serve basis. The Fair Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries per exhibitor.
9. Anyone leaving with their exhibited animals before 6:00 p.m. Sunday the previous year will be allowed barn space at the discretion of the Fair Committee and the Livestock Superintendents.
10. CATTLE ENTRIES MUST USE THE CATTLE ENTRY FORMS found in this book.
11. All clubs are requested to send their entries in together. Clubs should contact one of the superintendents prior to coming to the fair to avoid duplicate entries.
12. If two people are showing the same animal send entries in together and note as such.
13. Copies of health papers should be forwarded with entries. Please note STEERS: Confirmation of castration to be checked by veterinarian and noted in health papers.
14. Entry into the Junior Show will be limited to those who are 18 years and under. ANYONE OVER 18 YEARS OF AGE CANNOT SHOW FOR EXHIBITORS IN THE JUNIOR SHOW. Failure to follow these rules could result in forfeiture of premiums.
15. All cattle shown by Junior Exhibitors must be owned or leased by the exhibitor. Lease and/or REGISTRATION papers may be requested.
16. Exhibitors' tickets are \$10.00, and may be purchased from the Secretary at the time of entry and entitles holder to admission to the Fair for all four days. Children under 12 are FREE.
17. Please read all rules & regulations in the "General Information" section of this book.
18. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST CLEAN THEIR BEDDED AREA INCLUDING INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR AISLES BEFORE LEAVING THE FAIRGROUNDS ON SUNDAY. Bedded areas will be inspected and must be kept raked up at all times. Failure to clean bedded area Sunday night could result in forfeiture of all premiums.



- 19. EXHIBITORS MAY START TO CLEAN BEDDED AREAS AT 6:00 P.M. SUNDAY. No animals will be able to leave the fairgrounds before 6:00 p.m. Sunday. If there is a health problem with any animals please contact your superintendent.
- 15. All hoses hooked up to Four Town Fair water lines must have non-leaking pistol grip nozzles on them.
- 16. Due to the Rabies epidemic, we will have to follow strict guidelines on all cattle. Please bear with us and help make this a fun year for all.
- 17. Initial bedding is supplied. There is a limit of one (1) bale per animal (ring).

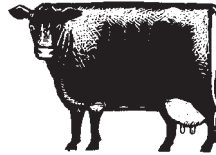
The Judge will consider the following points in making the awards:

- 1. Condition of hooves and trimming of hooves.
- 2. Clipping of head, ears, tail, body, etc.
- 3. Cleanliness and condition of hide and coat.

Showing of Animal by Exhibitor – 50%

- 1. Control of the Animal by exhibitor.
- 2. Appearance, poise and coolness of exhibitor.
- 3. Skill in showing the Animal to best advantage.

2. Exhibitors must provide feed, feeder, and water buckets. Also any equipment or stands.
3. All animal ages are as of fair date. Exhibitor age is as of January 1st this year.
4. All animals must be in place by Friday, by 7:00 pm. Animals may be penned on Thursday from 12:00 - 7:00 p.m.
5. No animals may be removed before 7:00 p.m. Sunday.
6. Lease papers and health papers to be kept on fair grounds while animal is there.
7. Advanced registration is required and must be received no later than 1 week before the fair.
8. Ribbons and their premiums will be awarded by the judge according to the merit of the animal and/or exhibitor. Judges decision is final. Premiums awarded on 1st to 6th place basis only.
9. All pens must be clean along with supply areas before leaving the fair. Failure to clean areas will mean forfeiture of premiums.
10. Registration ear tags and certificates shall agree on all registration papers and veterinarian certificates.
11. Discount exhibitors tickets (\$10.00) may be purchased from the secretary at the time of entry and entitles holder admission to the fair for all four days. Children 12 years and under are FREE.

RULES

1. Connecticut Fairs and Livestock Show Regulations - See General Requirements 2011 in the beginning of this year's book.
2. No sick bird or animal will be accepted.
3. All poultry shall adhere to the state of Connecticut's rules and regulations. All exhibition cages at poultry shows and fairs must be cleaned and disinfected after each show.
4. Water and feed will be supplied by the Fair. Any birds requiring special feed shall be supplied by the exhibitor and feeding arrangements shall be made with the superintendent in charge.
5. Poultry & pet stock can be brought in Wednesday or Thursday from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Judging at 9:00 a.m. Friday.

6. Poultry will be judged by the principles set forth in the Standard of Perfection of the American Poultry Association in all recognized varieties.
7. All birds must be owned by the exhibitor, and must be a recognized breed of poultry or waterfowl.
8. All exhibits brought in are at the sole risk of the exhibitor.
9. Exhibits must not be removed before 7 p.m. Sunday.
10. **All exhibits must be removed on Sunday evening no later than 8:30 p.m.**
11. Exhibitors must forward a list of their exhibits to the Fair Secretary no later than September 1st. Entries received after the deadline will **only** be accepted if the superintendent feels there is space available.
12. A maximum of 45 birds may be shown by one exhibitor, and/or their family in the Open-Poultry Class. A maximum of 10 birds may be shown by one exhibitor in the Youth-Poultry Class.
13. Exhibitors must fill out all spaces which apply to the entry on the proper entry form. All entry forms must be legible. Failure to comply could result in rejection of entry. Please print.
14. Entries must be on a "Poultry Entry Form." All forms must be filled out properly. No exceptions.
15. Failure to comply with any or all of the above rules and regulations may result in forfeiture of premium monies and/or expulsion from the fair grounds.
